San Joaquin County Ombudsman

Jill Hernandez is a native Stocktonian, only leaving town to attend and graduate with a B.S. degree in Recreation Administration from Fresno State University. She has been the LTC Ombudsman Coordinator for 10 years. Her duties include: 1) Receiving, investigating & resolving complaints on behalf of LTC residents; 2) Ensuring a regular presence in all LTC facilities in San Joaquin County; 3) Addressing patterns of poor practice in facilities; 4) Maximizing opportunity for community awareness & involvement; 5) influencing public policy when appropriate and 6) ensuring effective program administration. All of these above mentioned items would not be possible without the use of trained, dedicated & State certified Ombudsman Volunteers. Jill is also responsible to recruit, train & retain an appropriate number of volunteers to assist in resolving complaints & maintain the facility presence. The Ombudsman Training sessions are usually held 1-2 times a year & require 40-hour training over a 2 week time period. Jill also has numerous management duties such as program budget, volunteer recognition events, and attendance on several committees in the County and numerous requests from facilities for Mandated Reporter trainings.

Jill's past work experiences include managing a 'unique' gift / stationery shop in Fresno, CA. and 5 years working in a locked, private Psychiatric Hospital as a Registered Activity Therapist. Besides her full time job with Ombudsman, Jill is active in the Community by serving as Secretary for the Leadership Stockton Alumni Association; Board member for Sunflower Presents; and active auxiliary member for the Child Abuse Prevention Council Auxiliary in Stockton. Jill is married and has 2 children ages 12 and 10.
