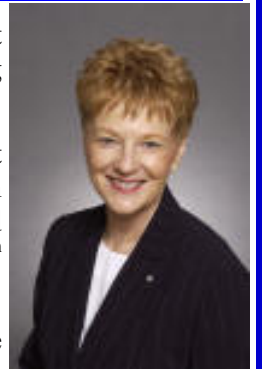
The Grapevine
