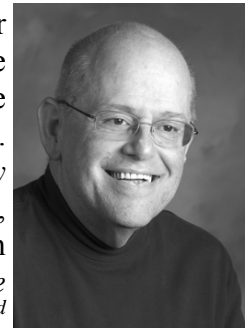

Jim's diverse career has spanned the worlds of theatre, opera and television. Jim's Broadway credits as a Musical Director include *Sweeney Todd*, starring Angela Lansbury, the 1983 revival of *Mame*, starring Angela Lansbury, and *Anything Goes*, starring both Patti LuPone and Leslie Uggams. National Tours include: *The Sound of Music*, *The Best Little Whorehouse in Texas*, *42nd Street*, *A Little Night Music*, *Show Boat*, and *Sweeney Todd*, which was subsequently released on video. At New York City Opera, Jim conducted *The New Moon*, *The Desert Song*, *Sweeney Todd*, *South Pacific*, and *The Student Prince*. As a Director, Jim's work has been seen all over the United States as well. 
